

The tactics for one rideshare company overlap with another most of the time so we strongly recommend that you sign up for BOTH Lyft and Uber at the same time and utilize our recommendations for making up to 2x (“double”) the income each day instead of just driving for one company. As most rideshare entrepreneurs know, there are only so many ride requests that one can process in one day, so drive smart. As an independent contractor, rideshare partners can drive for Lyft to take advantage of their 20% Power Driver Bonuses and frequent Hourly Guarantees up to \$40/hour and for Uber as well for their marketplace domination in the ridesharing industry.

This free e-book has been updated to include the latest information from our VIP Success Inner Circle, a group of businesses and companies that can help you succeed.

First, let’s take a look at ridesharing or carpooling which is a service that arranges one-time rides on a short notice with the leaders in the industry such as Uber, Lyft, Gett, Via and Juno.

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These companies serve as transportation network companies (TNC) through the use of the latest technological advancements in GPS and smartphones where users can request a driver, determine the driver's route and operate with a reliable layer of transparency for the entire process (“i.e. estimated time of arrival, photo of driver and vehicle”) of determining a driver's route and arranging the shared ride.

The entire process is coordinated through a network service which usually handles the payment instantaneously making the process safe and secure and totally "cashless" (Lyft allows for users to leave \$cash tips in the app) by using GPS location and other top-secret algorithms to optimize the process of “matching” a rider's request with a nearby TNC-verified driver.

While carpooling and ridesharing are similar in many ways, carpooling was developed to better utilize empty seats in most passenger cars going in the same direction to lower emissions and reduce pollution. Ridesharing is outsourcing of rider requests to commercial drivers equipped with mobile applications and smartphones. With the latest advances in technology, ridesharing and carpooling overlap, however ridesharing was really designed to serve one-time trips while carpooling has become more of scheduled trip arrangements.

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For the last six to seven years, transportation network companies (TNCs) such as Uber and Lyft have worked hard to become the top ridesharing transportation network companies. Ridesharing is the technical term for “outsourced” ridesharing where drivers didn't initially share the same destination with their passengers as in the case of most "carpooling" scenarios. With ridesharing, the mobile application “outsources” ride requests to TNC-verified driver-partners where they are rerouted at a cost based on the respective TNC Fee Schedule.

Many of these ridesharing companies faced many obstacles in their operation as a result of controversial issues such commercial insurance, licensure, registration, etc. resulting in Uber and Lyft been banned in cities across the U.S.A and Europe (i.e. the Fort Lauderdale “ban” July ’15 – October ’15).

The traditional taxi system have medallions (“licenses”) that are purchased for large sums of money and limits a certain number per a locality clashed with transportation network companies like Uber and Lyft because most TNC drivers are not required to carry expensive commercial insurance or have a special license.

In large urban cities like New York City and Chicago, taxi operators paid over \$1,000,000+ or more for medallions which are "rights" to operate a taxi. Many of these medallions were secured through bank financing and many of these banks and

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financial institutions specializing in deals in this industry have since filed for bankruptcy. These medallions can be resold, however their value has diminished due to the proliferation of transportation network companies (TNC) like Uber and Lyft.

Many banks serving the taxi owners have filed for bankruptcy because operators are unable to make their loan payments and they are unable to sell their medallions because they are unable to generate enough revenue due to loss of market share to the TNC’s in major cities all across the United States.

Simply put, technology adds value to and enhances the human experience and consumers have a right to determine how they spend their hard-earned money. The technology fueling the growth of the ridesharing industry is going to become more and more invasive to the point where trips can be outsourced over longer distances with multistage matching scenarios from one city to the next. TNCs will branch off into other income verticals such as UberEats and UberRush (courier services) and Uber-like Grocery Delivery Services. The ridesharing networks are increasing their dominance in the transportation industry by forming partnerships with some of America’s favorite retailers such as Starbucks, JetBlue, Costco, Whole Foods and many others for deeper market penetration and brand recognition.

With each year, the demand and popularity of ridesharing

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increases and at least 30% of mobile app users report using some kind of ridesharing service at least once a week. Despite the legality and regulation issues facing the ridesharing industry, ridesharing is here to stay and the demand for these services will continue to flourish and grow year after year. In 2017 alone, UberEats offers McDonalds delivery in Miami and deeper penetration beyond the mainstream Uber and Lyft service means more income opportunities for the TNCs.

It is interesting to note that the growth of the ridesharing industry coincided with the growth of smartphone use around 2012. As the smartphones gained market share, technology companies like Uber and Lyft faced stiff fines, risk of vehicle impoundment, bans and cease and desist notices of their ridesharing operations. TNCs have faced huge opposition in many cities like Los Angeles, Chicago and New York City.

After six to seven years of implementation and BILLIONS of ridesharing requests processed, the municipalities are now looking at traditional taxi companies to "up" their game and optimize their operation with powerful navigation software like Waze and smartphone apps to process real-time rider requests. City officials are now calling on traditional taxi companies to increase the layer of transparency in their operation by offering full functionality to riders similar to the Uber and Lyft mobile

applications.

As more and more cities begin to adapt to the growth of transportation service companies and optimize their city regulatory infrastructure to accommodate these companies, traditional taxi companies are being required to update their operations by offering transparent smartphone apps to process passenger requests in real-time for maximum transparency.

Based on a recent statistic from the Automobile Industry, the average car owner only uses their vehicle 4% of the time. With the average depreciation in the first year of a brand-new car somewhere around 10% - 15% of its initial value, a lot of young millennials are starting to “rethink” their car buying experience. This shift in the car buying paradigm is making the automobile manufacturers very nervous and they are trying to adapt to the changing landscape of the car buying experience. Toyota has partnered with Uber and General Motors has partnered with Lyft in an effort to remain competitive while TNC market penetration grows deeper and deeper into our everyday lives.

Whereas in the early 1990s where the use of email or telephone to arrange a "next-day" pickup by taxi was considered to be cutting-edge and revolutionary, the industry is trying to keep up with the instantaneous ride requests in real-time with the advent of transportation network companies like

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Uber and Lyft. Ridesharing has evolved to offer congestion fighting options like *UberPool* and *Lyftline* where multiple riders are matched to the closest driver by GPS location to process rider requests to nearby destinations. With the Clean Air Act, many cities are now offering ridesharing and carpooling services incentives to the TNCs in an effort to reduce the number of vehicle trips per a year in their respective city.

The IRS even allows tax benefits for pooling of transportation requests under Section 132(f) of the Tax Code via employer payroll deductions ("Commuter Tax Benefit").

Ridesharing has become so integrated into the fabric of our social networks that rideshare users often make statements like, "I am uberizing right now" or "I am in an Uber".

Newer TNCs such as Via received capital investment funding to building their TNC network and offer ridesharing services cheaper and cheaper (as little as \$5 plus tax flat rate in New York City). Their mission and goal is to develop a dynamic transportation system from the ground up and look to the future of licensing their technology and user base to municipal entities to fight congestion and reduce automobile emissions.

You are about to embark on an exciting journey into the ridesharing industry. If you have ever dreamed about owning your own business and being able to start a company and start

making money from Day One, then the ridesharing industry is for you. There is no other business like it. **Trust me!** Thanks to companies like Uber, Lyft and Via, the rideshare industry is changing the way people get from one destination to another.


### ***Section 1: How to Find the Best Pickups.***

Ridesharing and carpooling are not new concepts. You have seen the new HOV lanes on the highway designed to fight congestion and pollution. Uber, a ridesharing company, originated about seven years ago in San Francisco, California and its original model was initially called “Ubercab”. The founders had an idea to purchase 100+ luxury vehicles, hire drivers and rent garage space and offer a mobile application that would allow anyone with a smartphone to summon a luxury vehicle like a Mercedes S550 or BMW 750Li. After careful consideration, they dropped “cab” and they simply called their company “Uber” and reportedly paid \$1 Million for the Internet domain “Uber.com” and of course, the rest is history. They optimized their business model to simply allow “other” people with nice cars to process ride requests using their platform to connect drivers with riders who needed transportation. Here

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we are in 2017 and we are 1,500,000 – 2,000,000 Uber drivers strong in the United States and incredible growth and demand all around the world. Uber administers the smooth processing of ride requests and dispatches Uber Partners “drivers” to process these requests via the Uber Partner App. As a user of the Uber Partner App, once you have been approved to drive by Uber and you have uploaded all of your documents such as Vehicle Inspection, Driver’s License & Insurance, you’re ready.



This is the start-up screen. You can click on Home which will take you to the GPS pin of your current location. There are four points of navigation in the app. Home, Earnings, Ratings and Account (main screen may change with ongoing updates).


\***Home:** Main Screen of the Uber partner app.

\***Earnings:** Shows in real time your current earnings. Click on the dollar amount and it breaks down your daily earnings.

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When you click on the individual days of the Week of the breakdown of your Uber earnings, you will see each trip.



\***Ratings:** As a new Uber partner, you start with a rating of 5.0 and you work hard to maintain your rating as a rideshare partner (their rating system is constantly changing).

\***Account:** You can select Help, Waybill, Documents, and Settings and About options from this tab. Click on the Settings tab and you will be able to select your Navigation Provider.


***Section 2: How to take advantage of Surge Pricing***

Surge pricing is a great feature in the Uber Partner App because it has a direct impact on your earnings. With Lyft, their surge is called “Prime Time”. Surge pricing incorporates surge multiples into the standard GPS calculated cost per a mile (“TNC’s Fee Schedule”) and cost per a minute fare review. Surge pricing generally correlates to a high number of Uber requests in comparison to the number of Uber partners in a given location.

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Uber uses a proprietary algorithm to determine surge pricing at any given location. With real-time data constantly streaming into their system, surge pricing is continuously updated to reflect the level of demand in your area based on location.

The surge pricing in effect at this particular time shown (“March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2016”) at 2:24pm was for the Ultra Music Festival in Miami, Florida. The surge multiples were as high as 2.9x in

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some areas based on the high number of Uber requests to the number of Uber partners in the area who are available to respond to these requests. Uber does a great job when it comes to supporting their partners to position themselves for the surge. Check your inbox for Weekly Demand emails for concerts and special events. For example, if you were to receive a trip request in a 2.8x surge multiple zone at 2:24pm and your trip lasted 15 minutes over a 10 mile distance, the 2.8x would be applied to the standard \$0.95/mile + \$0.13/minute rate as stated in the Waybill of the passenger’s trip request. Surge multiples don’t apply to tolls and booking fees.

### ***Section 3: How to Choose the Best Times to Drive and Find the Best Zones in your Area.***

One of the best strategies for locating the great pickups based on my experience is to observe the times when most people use Uber during the week and on the weekends. During the week, the hot demand times will be 5am – 11am and 5pm – 8pm. On the weekends, it can be all day especially in big cities like Miami. Demand will be high in South Florida from Halloween to end of March. For large urban metropolitan cities

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like New York City and Los Angeles, there is peak demand at all times regardless of driver saturation. In NYC, prices surge!


Each city in the world has different regulations and rules for operation of Uber. In Broward County, Florida where the case study data originated for this course – Uber has an operating agreement with the County. Each Uber airport pickup generates \$4.50 in revenue for the county and each Uber cruise port pickup generates \$2.00 in revenue for the county. These fees are charged by Uber as reflected on the passenger’s receipt and this fee structure originated in October ’15.

Based on my experience with completing 5,000+ trip requests as of May, 2017 in the Miami/Fort Lauderdale area, these are the best times for high demand: 4am – 9am Monday – Friday and 4pm – 10pm Monday – Friday. **The best fares are airport fares.** On Christmas Eve, I netted on one Uber trip from Fort Lauderdale Airport to Port St. Lucie over \$92.00 plus \$100 tip for a total of almost \$192.

Airport Configuration: The Miami and Fort Lauderdale airports have a geo-zone – a so-called “*virtual zone*” around each airport. You will not receive a Uber “airport” request while on the airport property however once you drive into the geo-zone, you will be put into First-In, First Out (FIFO) Queue System (“wait”) for your turn. It is a fair and consistent system designed

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by Uber to allow Uber partners to orderly process the more profitable airport requests. If you live in a city where airport regulations are “friendly” to Uber Driver-Partners and (“you are lucky”) to make a living without the risk of citations, by all means you should focus on airport requests. The fares are more profitable and highway miles = less vehicle wear and tear.



If you live in the Miami area, MIA airport offers really great opportunities for income (abide by airport regulations/rules). The volume of air traffic and the level of international travel work in favor for Uber partners. Set your Favorites in your navigation app (“Waze”) so that you can tap and go to “Miami Tri-Rail Airport”. You can briefly wait in the “southernmost” parking lot for airport Uber requests. If you wait north of the star, Tri-Rail security will flag you down (“the star is the spot”).

Get a [Free Wellness Kit of Essential Oils](#) for Feng Shui. Protect yourself from MRSA and get a discreet layer of protection in restrooms, hotel rooms and in the gym from deadly bacteria.

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If you live in the Fort Lauderdale area, you can focus on airport requests all day and all night long and do quite well. If your goal is to make up to \$100 - \$150 a day, you should focus all of your energies on the airport. Just one ride request to West Palm Beach and net you \$60 plus a potential tip of \$20, which is very common for Uber Driver-Partners. Strike up a good conversation, maintain a clean vehicle with perhaps cool refreshments such as bottled water and mints and you have the prescription for success driving for Lyft and Uber.

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
Here is the “recommended” area to wait for KFLM Fort Lauderdale airport rider requests in the geo-zone:



It is a little tricky with waiting for requests at Fort Lauderdale airport. Do not wait on the east side of Griffin Road and US 1.

When was the last time you took a cruise? Did you know that you don’t have to pay full price. Learn the secrets of a 3-Stripe Officer who worked on a lot of ships that the cruise industry doesn’t want you to know. You could easily save 10% - 40% on your next cruise with [These Secrets of the Cruise Industry](#).


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You can watch the Queue system go to (0-10) “0” queue position – “10” minutes (“it means you’re next in line for a request”). Once I get to 0-10, I like to drive up and down the Griffin Road which is parallel to the runway to maximize the chance that I get the next airport request fast. Simply leave and drive on Griffin Road slowly at queue point “0-10” Wait/Queue and don’t go under I-95 or you will go out of the geo-zone and you will lose your queue spot in line (“FIFO”) and if you travel east on Griffin Road, don’t go north towards the Port, you may exit the geo-zone. Once your airport request arrives, accept it quickly and call the passenger to instruct them to meet you in the commercial area between the terminals. Many passengers already know where to go, if they travel frequently to South Florida airports. Each airport will have their own regulations for rider pickup so make sure that you abide by the rules for maximum profits as an Uber Driver-Partner and Lyft Driver.

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Most Uber partners wait in the “Ok” zone (see screenshot) above. You can also wait on the other side of the train tracks on SW 33th Street at night like I do.

Depending on whether you have an operating agreement in your city or county, you should seriously consider airport fares. Airport fares are usually longer, configured for UberPool which is great (sometimes UberPool will collaborate three parties of 1 person for a “triple” ride effect). Very nice! *Use UberPool to your advantage.* Try to accept as many UberPool requests as you can – you will get paid for the extra leg if you are in transit

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to pick up the 2<sup>nd</sup> rider. It is very lucrative and it helps you to rack up trip credits very fast towards the 100 trip credits required for monthly extension of your Uber Fuel Card.

This is the best tip for learning about your market: brainstorm market penetration (saturation of drivers to demand) by keeping the Uber rider app open to see where the Uber partners are mostly concentrated and make a list of these zones. If Uber partners keep returning to an area, it is because the area is a high demand zone (i.e. airport, college campuses, train station, metro mover system, etc.) and they is \$\$\$ there!

Did you know you can book a \$1,000 flight for \$20 or less in taxes every 60 days. Yes, it’s true! There are frequent fliers who are doing it every single day with a hidden loophole in the Airline and Credit Card System that less than 1% of travelers really know how to use to access huge savings. Don’t book another airline ticket and pay full price until you learn about this [Powerful Fly Almost for Free Airline Industry Secret](#).

### ***Section 4: How to get more Passenger Referrals***

Passenger referrals are very important to your earnings. Uber does a great job of offering special promotions for rider referrals. Many riders don’t know that they can invite friends from within the app to offer a free ride up to \$20 ride credit and they will also receive a Free Ride. Hand your Uber referral card to EVERY Uber rider. If they are really enthusiastic, give them 3 or 4 referral cards – especially college students. Your earnings from the rider referral program will show up as a “Rider Acquisition Rewards” on your earnings statement and they will be worth \$5 - \$20 depending on the Uber promotion.

I love to thumb tack referral cards to local laundry mat billboards in the Fort Lauderdale area and leave them in business card bowls at local restaurants. Some Uber partners leave their referral cards at train station restroom spots and rest spots on the Interstate. If you see a lot of people crowding around at a bus stop, you can walk up and simply hand out your Lyft and Uber Rider Referral cards. Ask them if they have ever used Uber before and let them know that they can use the rider referral card for a ride credit. There are a lot of ways to get Rider Acquisition Rewards added to your weekly payout for excellent passive income. Uber and Lyft Promotions vary.

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You can make quite a bit of cash just from cancellations alone! *This topic is controversial.* Uber is specific about their rules for waiting for the rider. This is a professional service and there are rules of etiquette to follow. For “you”, the Uber partner, when you arrive on time, it is unreasonable to keep the driver waiting. You may find that on a daily basis up to 20% of your net income payout may result from cancellation fees. When you arrive and wait for at least 5 minutes and the rider is considered “no-show”, you can cancel the trip with UberX. The rule is 2 minutes waiting with UberPool rides because you may have a party in the car waiting eagerly to get to their next destination.

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***Section 5: How to work smarter than other drivers***

Working smarter not harder is the best way to maximize your earnings. DailyPay no longer works with Uber because Uber’s app update features high levels of security which make it prohibitive for 3<sup>rd</sup> party companies to use their API (Application Programming Interface). You should definitely register for DailyPay, a 3<sup>rd</sup> party company for pay advance on-demand driving. You may work for other on-demand companies such as GrubHub, DeliveryDudes, Instacart and many more. It is a great company and great team of people that will advance you up to 90% of your earnings daily and withhold 10% reserve to cover incidental expenses. DailyPay is a great 3<sup>rd</sup> party company!

By utilizing the DailyPay service, you don’t have to wait for your weekly paycheck by direct deposit anymore. You can receive daily direct deposits to your bank account based on the 5:30pm previous day to 5:30pm current day “cycle” of your earnings activity for next day deposit. The following screenshots reflect daily earnings and my pre-set a %payout/%reserve with “Payment Received” reflect deposits submitted to the bank.

DailyPay offers great comfort in knowing that you don’t have to wait for each weekly paycheck to appear in your bank account on a Wednesday or Thursday mornings. You can elect to set up





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a savings account or checking account. Please keep in mind that savings accounts are subject to federal regulations of a maximum of 6 transfers (online, non-atm) and may be subject to penalties and fees and/or account closure if you exceed the regulated transfer limits. A checking account is the best option.

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DailyPay allows you to work smarter than other drivers because the system allows you to focus on being the best rideshare driver possible. **Update:** as of 11/3/2016, I am no longer a client of DailyPay however this section will remain as part of this e-book publication for educational purposes only. Due to security updates, DailyPay is no longer working with Uber Driver Partners for advancement of their Uber earnings on a daily basis. It was a really GREAT ride with DailyPay and their system worked great for the Uber On-Demand Platform, but life goes on and Uber’s security updates restricted DailyPay’s access.

***Section 6: How to take Tax Deductions to Maximize Profits***

As an independent contractor, it is important to keep track of all of your receipts. The IRS permits \$0.54 per mile business deduction for 2016. You should sign up for TripLog and it tracks your mileage effortlessly with a push of a button at the start of your shift and push Save to end your trip. Uber will provide you with a 1099-K at the end of the year and it only shows “in-trip” mileage. While “in-trip” is a good deduction by itself, you should check with your accountant or tax attorney to see if you may qualify based on your state to claim all mileage associated with related Uber activities such as driving to “scan” areas for Uber requests + “in-trip mileage”. You may spend a lot of time “Online” in the app without being in a trip which means that you are still working and on the job as an Uber Driver-Partner and should qualify for tax deduction. If you are using Uber’s sponsored weekly lease program where for as little as \$250 down, you can lease a relatively new vehicle with no credit check and pay in the range of \$148 - \$160 per a week and filing your tax return will be easy. Your lease is collateralized by your Uber earnings so there is minimal risk and Uber needs drivers! You would simply report your net earnings after Uber deducts the lease payment and keep track of your mileage and other expenses (i.e. meals, car wash, vacuum, etc.). Please check with your local tax attorney or accountant for professional advice.

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Say, have you downloaded and tried TripLog, a GPS/location based app for smartphones? [Click here to sign up for their service and get a 20% discount.](#) It is a great app that many Uber partners use to keep track of their mileage and expenses. It is very easy to use and you can subscribe to their full service for as little as \$2.50 a month which includes daily “sync” cloud storage of receipts and live trip data available for review on your account online (web & mobile). It is pretty amazing how much information, TripLog gathers about your ridesharing activity once it is activated. You can see the “zip-zag” of your Uber activity on a daily basis which is wild and crazy! Once you set up your account you can start registering your trips, fuel costs, expenses and compiling reports online for review either at the end of the year or weekly to optimize your rideshare earnings. There are some actual screenshots of TripLog below. It uses GPS live real-time tracking and you can enable various features to trigger the start of trips such as MPH speed limits (“MagicTrip”). You can automatically start trips when GPS is on, connected to Power or Bluetooth devices or moving over 5 mph. You can use TripLog GPS to search for locations and select to automatically upload all receipt photos to the Cloud. You should run an analysis report each day to compare miles driven to net dollars earned. You should shoot for 1:1 ratio which means you are earning at least \$1 for each mile you drive, which is a good conversion in the rideshare business. Based on

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my 1099-K Earnings Analysis included in this e-book publication, I was close to earning \$0.90/mile net. My best days with a few surge priced trips are 115 miles driven to net \$95 earned on the app for the day. This translates to \$0.82 earned per a mile (not including any IRS mileage deduction). Once you have TripLog running in the background which tracks your daily miles and speed at all times, you can easily glance at miles driven and net dollars earned in the app at different times of the day: 9am, 12pm, 3pm, and 6pm to stay on target with your goals. You will be able to monitor trends such as hot zones at certain times of the day, the best times to take airport requests, etc. Once you sign up to drive for Lyft and Uber, make sure to download TripLog and register for the full business version for only \$2.50/month and you’re going to love seeing your trip activity each day and being able to take a quick picture of your receipts (i.e. Taco Bell, Advance Auto Parts, etc.) to track your expenses. Once you take a quick picture of your receipts, simply throw away your paper receipt because your receipt photos will be automatically uploaded to the Cloud. For more advanced TripLog users, the app allows you to use the OBD-II Device Settings to read the accurate odometer directly from your vehicles OBD-II (On-Board Diagnostics) connector.

Tracking expenses such as cost of gas allows you to accurately pinpoint the best times to drive. You can track conversion of gas cost to Uber earnings to find out the best times to drive in your city. Best tip for saving money on gas: use GasBuddy (web or mobile app) to find the lowest cost gas in your area!

***Section 7: How to get a 5-Star rating “almost” each and every time.***


This section is very important. It has to do with your rating. As an Uber Partner and Lyft Driver who used the service as an rider for five months prior to becoming a Driver-Partner, I have witnessed many nervous partners who feared deactivation because their rating fell below 4.67 (both Uber and Lyft have minimum thresholds to protect the integrity of their brand). When you accept an Uber request, promptly drive to the destination. When the Uber rider approaches your vehicle and opens the door, recognize them by calling his or her name. First, you are making sure that the rider is in fact the party that requests the Uber and second, by addressing the party by their name, you are affirming them. ***People like to be affirmed by calling their name. It is human nature!*** Remember, you never get a second chance to make a first impression.

So many Uber riders have complained to me about previous rides where their Uber driver was a chain-smoker. Even if they don’t smoke in their cars, the odor of the tobacco smoke lingers and clings to everything (“clothes”) and being enclosed in a small car cabin can pose a few problems for Uber riders and it will be reflected negatively on your rating. By all means, if you have children, leave the child car seats at home. Uber riders

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HATE to see child seats when they enter an Uber vehicle. You should make sure that your car smells appropriate. Citrus air fresheners are safe and tolerable. Don’t wear any heavy perfume or cologne and you can easily scent the carpets with lavender carpet fresh from Target. You will receive many nice compliments from your Uber riders. Your passengers are putting a lot of trust in you and you don’t want to let them down in any way. Show your riders that you care about the cleanliness of your vehicle. *Vacuum regularly and be sociable.*

Unless you get clear signals that the Uber rider(s) are not willing to engage in conversation, strike up a conversation. It will do wonders for your rating and help you to enjoy your ridesharing experience. Great conversation will help you enjoy your experience as an Uber Driver-Partner and Lyft Driver and you never know what jokes you will get from your riders. Some of these jokes, you will remember for the rest of your life. Many times, your riders will enter the vehicle with a cup of coffee or soda or a bottle of water that been refrigerated. If you have cloth seats, there is nothing worse than a big condensation watermark to trap dirt and become an eye sore for your next Uber rider. I like to keep a full paper towel roll handy. To solve this problem, kindly offer clean and fresh paper towels to your Uber riders and kindly ask them to place it under the bottle or cup to prevent a spill. They will appreciate your consideration.



***Navigation, navigation, navigation!*** What can I say – if you are a professional, act like one! Use the latest and greatest mobile navigation. I highly recommend Waze (screenshot above) – you will see road hazards, road closures and so much more!

*What would our lives be like without Waze?* It is the best app out there for *sync-mapping* the address from the Uber and Lyft apps to get great directions in real-time to assist with dropping off your riders “exactly” at their desired destination.

Waze is free to download and you can configure it to set vehicle hazard, road closures and accidents and so much more. Waze works well because it integrates feedback from fellow Wazers (“other users”) and makes this feedback available in real-time.

One of the best little tricks I have learned for getting these wonderful 5-star ratings is pretty simple and it involves the Law of Reciprocity and the Law of Attraction. When you are within 50 feet of the desired destination, quickly pull up the Uber Partner app and while the Uber rider is still seated, say, “Well, thank you {name}, I hope that you have a great day/night – I am going to go ahead and give you 5-stars because you are great. I wish all of my riders were like you!” Point to the rating on the app with your index finger and complete the rating action of your Uber rider while you still have their attention and they are seated in your car. Let the Law of Reciprocity kick in so that you can earn your 5-star rating. This tactic worked 9 out of 10 times to assure that I got 5-star ratings. *It has worked for 5,000 combined Uber and Lyft trips!* Your rating is very important.

In 9 out of 10 cases, the Uber rider will see than you did everything you could to make sure that they stay in good standing with Uber to ensure that they continue to keep using the Uber service (so many times they don’t know that Uber partners also rate the Uber riders). The Law of Reciprocity and Law of Attraction should go into full gear and help assure a 5-star rating.

This tactic works wonders even if you have a difficult rider (sometimes!) Many Uber riders don’t want to leave a situation with tension that you can literally cut with a knife so you can use this “end trip 100 feet early and rate with your index finger” technique. *A picture is worth a thousand words.*

Supplemental for Lyft Power Drivers: Lyft is Uber’s rival in the marketplace and while it is about a 1/3<sup>th</sup> of the size of Uber, it boasts high Driver Satisfaction. If you ask most Lyft drivers, they rave about Lyft’s in-app tipping feature and Lyft’s 10% Power Driver and 20% Power Driver Bonuses! These bonuses are important because if you are just starting out with Lyft, your service fee (“commission”) is going to be 25%. So do the math: earn a 20% Power Driver Bonus and pay 25% commission to Lyft on each ride – you end up only paying 5% to use Lyft’s platform to process ride requests. Your Driver Bonuses are

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determined by your acceptance rate which must be 90% or higher, the number of peak hour trip requests processed and the total number of call requests processed in one week. The payout structure is always subject to change to when you first start driving for Lyft, the Lyft Driver app will notify you of what is required for you to earn the Weekly 20% Power Driver Bonus.



*Ok...was it worth it?* Here is my 1099-K combined analysis of my 2016 earnings driving for Uber and Lyft. My 2016 gross earnings was about \$45,000 if you include about \$900 in Uber airport cash tips. **I had TWO months of \$5,000 Gross Earnings.** March was the peak of the 2016 cruise season and August was when students start preparing to go back to school. My Average Weekly Net Earnings was \$608.16. If you drive smart, you can earn about **\$0.90/mile net** plus factoring in cash tips!

Even if you just want to test the waters on the weekends or late at night at the airport to make an extra \$300 a week – the Lyft and Uber Driver Platforms offer income opportunities from Day One. After all, chance favors the prepared mind. **Be in the right place at the right time for the best fares.** *You’re the boss. Make it happen!*

You must use due diligence to determine the best zones in your city and figure out how to start using surge pricing to your advantage and learn more about the airport regulations and rules in your city/county. Check if Uber and Lyft are ok there.

Once you are up and running as an Uber Partner and Lyft Driver, stay tuned to Weekly Demand updates in your area. Visit Live Nation for concert information online to learn about festivals and concerts coming up in your city. By all means, you can use the Uber rider app to observe patterns of concentrated demand and gravitate to these “hot zone” areas to maximize your Uber and Lyft earnings. Use technology to drive smarter.

It is really your call if you are okay with working the local bar scene. Many Uber Partners shy away from “alcohol related” request scenarios for a variety of reasons as I did most of the time. When the sun sets, my mind shifts to making as many

airport trips as possible. Being able to work with highly intoxicated riders is not for everyone. You may not have the patience or tenacity (“it wasn’t my cup of tea”). ***It’s your call.***

You can easily put in a lot of hours on the Uber and Lyft app from “sunrise to sunset” and if airport regulations are permissible in your area, once the sun goes down, you can focus on the airport requests. You should visit online Uber forums like Uberpeople.net to learn about challenges facing Uber partners in your area. You will learn a lot about Uber by going on YouTube and watching videos posted by other Uber partners. Keep an optimistic view about going into ridesharing.

If you stay focused and follow the ridesharing tactics dictated in this e-book, you can be successful. If you only want to work 10 hours a week and make up to \$300 extra each week, the Uber and Lyft platforms are for you. If you want to go full-time and put in 40 hours a week and shoot for \$700 a week, the Uber and Lyft platforms is for you. You have the flexibility. ***Go for it!***

One of the beauties of these ridesharing platforms is that it gives you, the Driver-Partner 100% flexibility to dictate your own hours. Uber and Lyft are constantly updating their apps and Uber’s Instant Pay and Lyft’s Express Pay means you can get paid up to 3 times a day in a flash. ***It’s pretty amazing!***
